Reporting to the Assistant Director of IT, the IT Technician acts as a first respondent to support IT operations at the Maisonneuve and Viau container terminals. He holds a key role in ensuring the quality of the service provided and, through a rigorous work ethic, improves its efficiency and fosters its growth.

Your responsibilities will be to:

- Provide IT expertise, as a first respondent to intervene with unionized and non-unionized employees within the company and the Maritime Association;
- Receive requests from various employees (in person, by phone, by e-mail), prioritizing them, monitoring their progress, and ensuring their resolution, per the level of service required;
- Identify issues, finding timely solutions, and assisting employees using established channels.
- Escalate technical complex cases to the appropriate members of the IT team.
- Perform tasks related to the configuration, installation, operation, and troubleshooting of mobile devices, gatehouse kiosks, office computers, printers, and the telephone system;
- Provide different teams with support and training for various computer equipment and related software;
- Improve communication and sharing information by maintaining an informative written knowledge base;
- Participate in testing and documenting new technical features when required;
- Monitor the creation of user accounts and accesses to the IT systems;
- Manage all computer equipment and systems (monitoring, repairs, warranties, contact with suppliers);
- Contribute to the implementation, migration and integration projects:
