# IMPORTANT FOR TRUCK DRIVERS

## Your valid port pass?

(It must be visible and worn above the waist at all times while you are at the port facilities)

- **The valid booking or pickup #?**  
(check before arriving at the port)
- **Your securing pins unlocked and your electrical hookups unplugged before arriving at the terminal?**
- **Your pins locked upon exiting the terminal?**
- **The right container?**  
(verify the # when loading and that you have the correct container spot and section. Be sure to be aware of the layout and numbering of the sections)
- **Your safety equipment?**  
(safety hat, safety boots, safety vest with reflective strips)
- **The appropriate equipment in the event of a load of dangerous goods?**  
(place the signs before entering)
- **A passenger or apprentice driver with you? Inform the terminals 24 hrs ahead of time!**  
(underage passengers are not permitted)

## Arrival time

You must arrive **before 2:30 p.m.!** (If not, your company will be charged additional fees for requesting the Late Gate procedure)

\* Rules specific to MGT:

- Your company must be registered with MGT (always verify with your company before arriving at the port)
- The truck driver must be biometrically registered with MGT.
- If you are transporting a load for maritime shipping services that require the UIIA for departing containers, be sure that your company has its UIIA.



# Communication between the truck driver and Transtainer (RTG) operator

- Please use your fingers or the numbered signs (1 to 6) to indicate to the Transtainer operator the pile where your container is located.
- Do not count the empty spaces. Count only existing piles. Pile #1 is closest to the truck.

## EXAMPLES



THE FOLLOWING CODES ARE USED ONLY TO INDICATE THE HEIGHT POSITION IN THE PILE. (RACINE, EMPIRE STEVEDORING, TERMONT AND LOGISTEC TERMINALS) \* EXCEPTION: CAST TERMINAL

THE FOLLOWING SYMBOLS ARE TO BE USED AT CAST TERMINAL:  
FOOT = 1; KNEE = 2; WAIST = 3; HEAD = 4
