Object: Update on Termont's appointment system (RDV)

Dear partners,

Monday January 15th marked the official launch date of Termont RDV system!!!

The project has been warmly received by the transportation community as we benefit from a strong collaboration from dispatchers and truckers.

The deployment process is following its course, as communicated on December 22^{nd.} and we are pleased to inform you of the next milestone of Termont RDV system. Starting Thursday January 25th, 2024, the Online Gate System (Sherpa) will be taken offline.

Effective immediately, a message on the Online Gate (Sherpa) application page is displayed to inform users about the tool's offline date.

Here is what you need to know about the Online Gate System (Sherpa) going offline <u>effective</u> <u>Thursday, January 25th</u>:

Trucker access via portal entrances :

- The Sicard entrance (section 52, stage 1/pregate) giving access to Viau terminal is strictly reserved to truckers with an appointment (RDV). Two (2) lines (1 et 2) are provided for the exclusive use of Termont appointments (RDV)
- Truckers visiting Viau terminal, section 52, without an appointment (RDV) must do their transactions via the Port of Montreal portal entrance (section 75, stage 1/pregate)
- Lines 15 and 19 at the Port of Montreal portal entrance (section 75, stage 1/pregate) are
 reserved exclusively to Termont RDV system. Electronic billboards above these lines will
 indicate a message to guide truckers: Line 15 will display: "Termont 52 appointment
 only" and line 19 will display: "Termont 68 appointment only" starting Tuesday January
 23rd
- Truckers with an appointment will have access to all lines at the Port of Montreal portal entrance (Section 75, stage 1/pregate)



Here is a reminder about some key dates to remember:

- Mobile application available on Android and IOS in **February 2024**, before the mandatory implementation of Termont RDV system
- Mandatory Termont RDV from Monday, March 4th, 2024.

We reiterate our objective to offer a user-friendly tool used by all transport companies while bringing added value to the supply chain stakeholders. This will be achieved by adding decision support modules and by giving more visibility on the average truck turn time (TTT) at our terminals. Appointments will be allocated in sufficient quantity to allow for planning of our workforce capacity to meet the needs of the logistics community and to provide a stable TTT.
